Nursery and both Reception classes got to enjoy a visit to Vauxhall City Farm where they saw many different animals and got the opportunity to feed them.



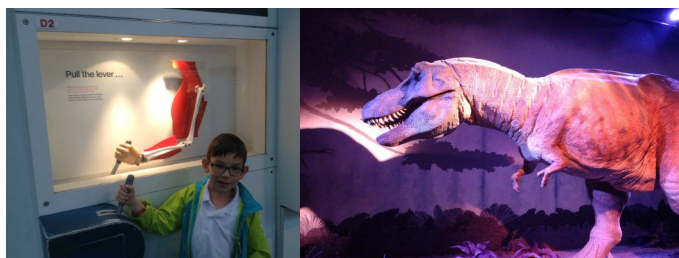
